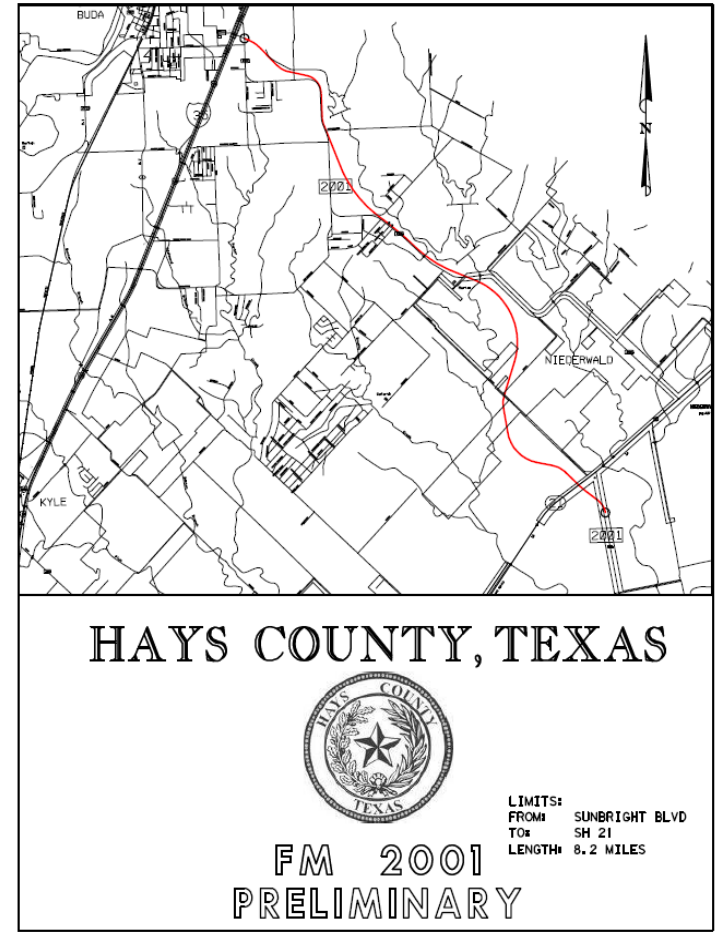


COUNTY PROJECTS IN THE WORKS

Construction Progress

The FM 1626 Safety Expansion Project will widen the current two lanes of FM 1626 from FM 967 to south of Drode Lane to a four-lane highway with a continuous left turn lane. The Project is being developed by Hays County in cooperation with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) as part of a Pass-Through Finance arrangement. Construction on the Project is estimated to be completed in Spring of 2014 and will provide a significantly safer facility for the residents and visitors of Hays County.

As Precinct Two Commissioner in Hays County, Texas, I am very excited to see the FM 1626 Safety Expansion Project move to construction. This is a very important project for Hays County. 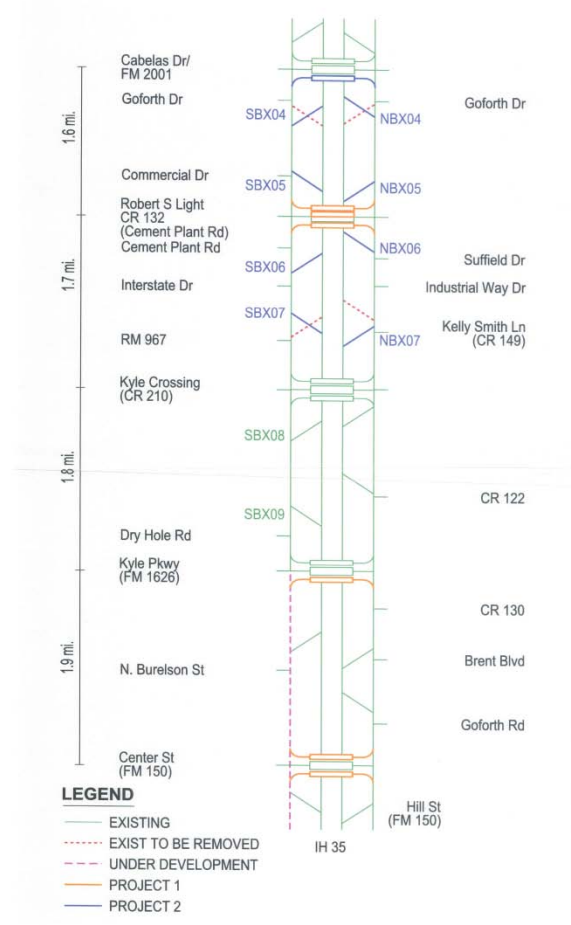
