

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUDA, TEXAS, EXPRESSING GRATITUDE TO SENATOR DONNA CAMPBELL FOR HER SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF BUDA DURING THE 83RD SESSION OF THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE.

Whereas, during the 83rd Session of the Texas Legislature, investor owned utility companies misused a loophole in state law to decline to provide adequate fire protection infrastructure to the communities they served, thereby endangering public safety and economic development; and

Whereas, after listening to citizens in the communities of Kyle, Buda, and Cibolo, Senator Donna Campbell, along with her Legislative Director Tanya Vazquez, Chief of Staff Bonnie Bruce, and staff worked tirelessly to secure the passage of legislation which empowered local municipalities to monitor and regulate the fire suppression infrastructure provided by investor owned utility providers in their communities; and

Whereas, Senate Bill 1086, signed by the Governor after the efforts of committed legislators like Senator Campbell, will improve the safety of the Citizens of Buda and ensure adequate fire protection for their homes and businesses;

Now, Therefore be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Buda, Texas that:

The City Council of the City of Buda wishes to recognize the efforts of Senator Donna Campbell and her staff in securing passage of legislation so vitally necessary to guarding the public safety and economic vitality of our community, and further wishes to express the sincere gratitude of the Citizens of Buda to Senator Campbell for her dedication and effectiveness on this issue.
