**MAKING BUDA BETTER TAKES VOLUNTEERS TO SERVE**

***The City of Buda has openings on various Boards/Commissions***

**Planning and Zoning** - *This Board serves as an advisory Board to the City Council in matters related to ensuring planned and purposeful development of the City of Buda and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, to protect the integrity of our natural resources and neighborhoods, and to enforce State and local statutes and Ordinances; meets twice a month.*

**Zoning Board of Adjustment** – *This Board has the authority to hear and decide appeals where the applicant alleges that there is an error in any order, requirement, decision, or determination made by City staff or the City Council in the enforcement of the City’s zoning regulations and ordinances; to hear and decide requests for special exceptions to the City’s zoning regulations and ordinances; to hear and decide judicial variances. This Board meets only on an as needed basis at Buda’s City Hall.*

**Historic Commission** – *This Board serves as an advisory Board to the City Council in matters relating to heritage and historic preservation activities in the City’s Historic District, events and projects for the benefit of the City and its Citizens. This Board meets monthly at Buda’s City Hall.*

**Parks & Recreation Commission** – *This Board serves as an advisory Board to the City Council in matters relating to policies, rules and regulations of a public parks and recreation program. They provide oversight of public playgrounds, athletic fields, recreation centers, and other park facilities. This Board meets monthly at the Buda’s City Hall.*

**Library Commission** – *This Board serves as an advisory Board to the City Council in matters relating to policies for the operation of the library facilities and services for the City of Buda. This Board meets monthly at the Buda Library.*

**Buda Economic Development Corporation** -*Encourages diverse business development and expansion. New business development as well as existing business expansion is a primary focus for economic development in Buda. This policy addresses issues such as infrastructure improvements and partnership fostering which will ultimately positively position the City of Buda to effectively recruit new business as well as help existing business expand.*

**Local Government Corporation** - *This Board is responsible for the receiving, investing and disbursing of all funds of the Corporation, accounting for and reporting on all financial activity, coordinating the independent audit, budget development and administration and Project financing for projects on the Cabela’s Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone.*
