

RESOLUTION _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUDA, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AUSTIN REGARDING THE CITY OF BUDA'S CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A GATEWAY "WAYFINDING" SIGN ON THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RIGHT OF WAY OF IH-35 SOUTH AND WITHIN THE CITY OF AUSTIN LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City of Buda ("City") desires to construct a gateway monument sign ("Gateway Monument") within the State's right-of-way on IH-35; and

WHEREAS, subject to compliance with the terms and conditions of a Gateway Monument Agreement, the State will allow the City to construct a Gateway Monument at the north side of the Main Street exit of IH-35 between the IH-35 Main Lanes and frontage road (Monument Location"), Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUDA, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Monument Location is located within the City Limits of the City of Austin, Texas.

SECTION 2. The Cities of Buda and Austin desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement wherein each City can construct a Gateway Monument within the other City's City Limits.

SECTION 3. As stated in the Agreement, the City acknowledges all responsibility for all costs related to the installation of the Gateway Monument. The City additionally commits to ensuring the long-term maintenance of the Gateway Monument, including, maintaining associated landscaping and lighting, timely removing graffiti, and repairing and/or removing the Gateway Monument as stated in the Agreement.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
